

Works Cited / Works Consulted

Based on MLA Style 4/09 (Revised 9/09)

SOURCES IN NON-PRINT: Online, Film, TV, Sound Recordings, Interviews

PAGE FORMAT:

1. The title should read, "Works Cited" or "Works Consulted" and be centered at the top of the page.
2. The entire list of citations should be alphabetized by the first letter of each citation.
If the citation begins with A, An, or The, **include** the A, An, or The, but alphabetize by the **2nd word**.

CITATION FORMAT:

1. The first line of the citation is flush with the left margin. The second line is indented five spaces.
2. Double space within the citation. (This was not done in the examples below in order to save space.)
3. Double space between citations.
4. City Format: If the city is unfamiliar across the nation, include the postal abbreviation of its state. E.g. Redmond, WA
5. Date format: day mon. year. If there is no date, write **n.d.**

Months are written as follows: **Jan. Feb. Mar. Apr. May June July Aug. Sept. Oct. Nov. Dec.**

If no date appears on the page, type in the address bar: **javascript:alert(document.lastModified)** and press return.
